

The Light and Lacey Knit Scarf by Kathy Bartholomew



MATERIALS

Yarn, 250 yards worsted, light worsted, #3 or #4 size yarn, Sample used Lion Brand Shawl in a Cake

US10 Knitting needles

Removable Stitch Marker, or small piece of contrast yarn

Darning Needle

Tape Measure

TERMINOLOGY

CO – Cast On

K – Knit

YO - Yarn Over

K2Tog – Knit 2 Together

BO – Bind Off

INSTRUCTIONS

Using Long Tail, Cast on 24 stitches (or use Knitted Cast on if you prefer)

Knit 2 rows

Now for the lacey element:

Knit 3, *YO, K2Tog, repeat until you have 3 stitches left, K3, turn

Repeat the last row until almost out of yarn. Knit 2 rows, then bind off loosely. Weave in ends

There you go, a nice and easy knit scarf that is light and lacey. You will be knitting these in no time. Take your time to get comfortable with the yo, k2tog.

As a reminder, you will have 3 (K) stitches on both edges and 9 (yo, k2tog) clusters in between the knit stitches.
